Renew your membership! Membership is year to year, with renewals due the first of the year. But you can renew at any time!

\$20 for one artist group (Craftmakers, Sculptors, Photographers, or Painters) and \$10 for the Collective for a total of **\$30.** Add \$20 for any additional artist group(s) you choose.

To **RENEW** your Membership or to **JOIN** for the first time: Go to https://www.centralcoastartistscollective.org Select **JOIN US.**

- Select "Join or Renew" in the first box. This is required.
- Enter your first and last name and your email address (required).
- Fill in the Optional fields. These are not necessary if you are renewing unless your information has changed.
- Check the boxes for the groups you wish to join. They may be the same or different from those to which you currently belong. Please check at least one of these boxes.
- The final step in the process before payment is to Save your information. This is a required step.
- After Saving, scroll down to the payment section. Select PayPal or Credit Card, Send a check by mail, or No payment-Exit.

Select the number of Artist Groups.

Featured Artist - Jewel DeMoss

Jewel DeMoss has had decades of art experience and practice in the forms of acrylic and mixed media. Her work displays scenes of "women and their varied lives" through abstract themes of joy and distress, darkness, and light. Jewel uses acrylic paint in her pieces but often adds mixed media such as paper, fabric and/or anything else she finds interesting.

"I have had art in my heart all my life, but when I retired from the University of California, I was able to claim art as my life's work. I experimented and moved from medium to medium beginning with watercolor and ending where I am now: acrylic and mixed media. There are not sufficient words to describe my excitement in finding mixed media. It provides so much opportunity to play and to

experiment. I create on paper or canvas and try to reflect a piece of life or a significant issue or event in my paintings. I love creating figurative art and enjoy pushing myself to become more abstract. Recently I have begun trying to create abstract images from landscapes and cityscapes or from just my mind."

Jewel has had her art accepted into many juried exhibits throughout California and has won various awards from Best of Show to Honorable mention. Her work lives in many homes throughout California.

New Director for Craftmakers

We are pleased to announce that Craftmakers has a new director, **Lisa Stromsoe.**

Lisa has been involved in Fine Craft for 45 years, as a successful gallery owner, consultant, curator, and juror on a national scale. When SLOMA was an Art Center, she worked for decades to promote the Craftsmakers Group and present their widely popular exhibitions.

She has owned and managed three fine craft galleries, and at one time represented 138 artists nationwide. In addition to being selected as a past juror for the prestigious American Craft Council Shows, Lisa has worked alongside the Craft in America Learning Center and other groups that support and celebrate fine craft.

Lisa and her metalsmith husband, Randy Stromsoe, were among the original founding artisans of Studios on the Park in Paso Robles, under the directorship of visionary Anne Laddon. Lisa and her sister, Lori Buzzetti, were instrumental in the early stages of development of the S.O.T.P. Art Smart Program through their personal support and their small foundation, www.avalonfoundationslo.org

Lisa's goals include actively expanding the group by helping to meet members' needs in terms of exhibitions, education, and a broader shared artist community. She'd like to bring the group into the national dialogue on Fine Craft, which she believes is attracting attention from a new audience in the international art scene.

We welcome Lisa to Craftmakers and look forward to an exciting future for this art group!




